Saturday - Firing Line Commands

- 1. Has everyone finished putting up targets? I would ask that you ALL please stop talking and pay attention while I read you the range rules.
- 2. You will note the two coloured lights on the roof at either end of the firing and in the middle. The GREEN light is the FORWARD light, when it is glowing you may go forward. The RED FLASHING light is the BACK light, when it is FLASHING as it is now you must stay BACK behind the firing line at all times. Under no circumstances will any person or part of any person cross the firing line while that RED LIGHT IS FLASHING.
- **3.** The **FIRING LINE** is classed as the **FRONT EDGE OF THE BENCH TOPS**, along through each of the **FIELD RIFLE POSTS** on the right hand side and onto the range boundary fences on either side of the range property.
- **4.** You will **OPEN** your actions **IMMEDIATELY** after the firing of each shot and **WHENEVER** your firearms are moved in any manner at any time. This means your actions will be **OPEN AT ALL TIMES** unless you are in the actual process of firing a shot.
- 5. You will load SINGLE ROUNDS ONLY. This means you are permitted to use your MAGAZINE LOADED WITH A SINGLE ROUND ONLY. However, MULTIPLE round loading of your magazine is permitted but only whilst under the DIRECT Supervision of a Range Officer.
- 6. WHILE UNDER THE COVERED AREA OF THE FIRING LINE and the red light is flashing you must wear eye and ear protection. You must wear shoes or boots, at all times, when under the covered area of the Firing line.
- **7.** If you have any problems or safety concerns, please do not hesitate to contact any Range Officer for advice or assistance.
- 8. The range is now OPEN you may COMMENCE FIRE
